Booktopia Ships Books Faster and Easier with Zebra's TC8000

Headquartered in Sydney, Booktopia is Australia's leading online book retailer and local bookstore for all Australians. As a customercentric brand, Booktopia focuses on delivering the highest quality of customer service with fast delivery of books Australia-wide, including in regional and rural areas as well as New Zealand.

Booktopia ships over 3.3 million parcels a year to Australian and New Zealand addresses. At peak times, the online retailer has shipped 41,800 units per day. Booktopia's technology decisions are focussed entirely on enabling it to efficiently ship this extremely high volume of books out of the warehouse and fulfil customer orders, while maintaining an outstanding level of customer service.

Challenge

Known as Australia's leading online book retailer, Booktopia needed to uphold its reputation by deploying sophisticated and productive technology at its 13,000 square meter warehouse.

When the incumbent, dated Windows CE mobile technology threatened the efficiency of Booktopia's picking and put away operation, Booktopia needed a solution that would complement its custom warehouse management system (WMS) and give it the flexibility to innovate.

The company also needed a highly reliable device with battery life sufficient to last the full length of an employee's shift, that would produce less operator fatigue than its Windows devices.

Importantly, the company required a solution that would also improve staff satisfaction, and therefore boost efficiency and productivity of its warehouse operations.

Booktopia investigated a number of Android-based mobile computers that could increase staff satisfaction, overall efficiency and productivity, and provide flexibility to innovate.

Solution

An Android-based mobile computer with fast scanning capabilities

Booktopia engaged Skywire, a Zebra Premier Solutions Partner, as its trusted mobility partner to help pilot a solution. Booktopia ran a time-in-motion study to test a number of devices. Zebra's TC8000 Mobile Computer was a clear winner, offering additional features and instant staff satisfaction during the test phase. Booktopia therefore opted to go with Zebra's TC8000 mobile computer.

It was important for us to have the right technology in place to support innovation and growth

To ensure a solid workflow during the transition phase, 80 Zebra TC8000 mobile computers were deployed in multiple phases over 18 months, beginning in 2017. Eight devices were used during the test phase, and the remaining devices were introduced in blocks of twenty.

This approach enabled Booktopia's internal IT team to dedicate resources to the development of Booktopia's custom warehouse management system to deliver an extremely smooth rollout with no impact on warehouse productivity.

The benefits of the TC8000 mobile computer were seen almost immediately: staff satisfaction improved dramatically. In particular staff found the Zebra TC8000s able to scan much more efficiently than the previous devices, creating significant time savings. Furthermore, staff reported the Zebra devices to be lighter, more ergonomic, and

more comfortable to operate for 3-4 hours at a time. For example, the TC8000s were fitted with a wrist strap, leaving workers'

hands free for other tasks.

Additionally, the Zebra TC8000s were far more robust and needed far fewer repairs than the previous devices. Booktopia reported the old devices frequently resulted in broken triggers and damaged laser scanners, impacting productivity.

Overall, the Zebra TC8000s increased productivity and accuracy significantly across Booktopia's warehouse operations, resulting in massive time savings across Booktopia's distribution centre workforce.
